

Which US universities and subjects show the highest *improvements* in grades?



Data collection

Grade inflation in higher education

Grade inflation refers to a trend where the average grades awarded to students improve over time, without an increase in actual academic achievement. A trend that has been observed at many American universities since the 1960s. Grade inflation within higher education is an important phenomenon with strong impact on students, universities and the labor market. Changing grading standards make it harder for employers and universities to choose outstanding candidates as high GPAs become increasingly common and variation in grades decreases. Similarly, grade inflation makes it more difficult to compare academic performance across universities, both nationally and internationally, as institutions differ not only in grading standards, but they are changing at different rates.

A goal would be a balance between recognizing exceptional achievements and avoiding uninhibited inflation of grades, which makes it most crucial to know where and to what extent grade inflation is happening across American universities.

Transparency through data

This analysis uses data from 335m+ individual course grades in the US. Nearly 700 American universities have provided case with information regarding their yearly course grade distributions since 2015 in a variety of subjects.

Grade inflation scores were calculated as the average increase or decrease in mean GPAs within all courses that the respective university offered compared to the previous year. Those grade inflation scores are then averaged and aggregated over a ten-year period for robustness. A positive average change in GPAs signals a general trend of grade inflation while a negative average change signals grade depletion. This overall grade inflation indicator is used to compare universities overall.

The large variety of subjects across all universities are grouped into 8 broader subject categories to provide an easier overview. For each subject category separate grade inflation scores are calculated for all universities to enable the comparison of subject specific grade inflation between universities.

What is case?


Education and labor market data

case aims to improve the admission and recruitment of students with the help of data. To enable an objective and fair assessment of achievements, educational and labor market data is collected globally. This enables case to place university degrees in their respective context. With this we support universities and companies in their selection as well as students in their self-assessment and support their entry into the job market. 
Contextualization of achievement

To assess educational degrees, it is necessary to understand the respective context in which they are achieved. For this purpose, case makes two types of comparisons based on data:

- 1. Comparison within a peer group: How well did someone do compared to other students in their program? We use the grade distribution in the specific course of study at the respective university to answer this.
- 2. Comparison between different peer groups: How well do students in a particular program perform relative to others? To determine this, case collects performance tests and labor market indicators to compare students at different universities and in different subject areas.







Grade inflation in other countries

Grade inflation is a global phenomenon. For this comparison, we convert international grading scales linearly to the US system using the best and worst possible grades as extremes. Two effects are striking:

- (1) The use of grading systems differs strongly between countries. In Italy and the US, average grades are already very close to the maximum and there is limited room left to measure differences in student performance. Moreover, the widely applied method of converting individual grades linearly between grading systems leads to absurd and unfair results.
- (2) Grading standards are not fixed but change over time. The closer average grades are to the maximum of the respective scale, the less room for future grade inflation remains. In the past decade, especially Germany and Portugal have shown worrying rates of grade inflation. This leads to big challenges when comparing grades over time.

Subject differences in the US

Within the US, not only grading itself but also grade inflation varies strongly by subject. For the ranking of the subject categories (Table 1), the average grade as well as 10-year grade inflation was determined for different subject categories based on course data across all universities.

With an average grade of 3.55, educational sciences have hardly any room left for further grade improvements. As a result, the rate is lowest (+0,05), but still positive. The strongest grade inflation in the last decade occurred within social sciences (+0.18). Natural sciences grade harshest and show only average grade inflation tendencies (+0,12).

Comparison: Ivy League

Grade inflation can be observed in all kinds of universities – public or private, prestigious or new. But in America the Ivy League universities have been the particular focus of many discussions regarding grade inflation. The eight Ivy League universities have historically been known for their selectivity and excellent academic achievements. Awarding students with only the highest of grades can boost such an image of academic excellence. In general, it also improves the labor market options of graduates, which is beneficial for universities as well, if it leads to higher donations.

High average GPAs – as is the case with all Ivy League universities – combined with a steady grade inflation will, however, lead to a point when grades reach the upper ceiling where differences in performance cannot be distinguished anymore. If grades cannot measure differences in performance, grading systems may become obsolete.


1. Use of the case web-platform


Conversion of grades
